CODEBOOK

Main variable:

UN and AU Sanctions on state and non-state actors

The codebook covers the entire collection of data and scoring of the variable mentioned above on a 0-3 basis.

Definition of the indicator:

Official data on whether or not economic and other sanctions have been imposed on a country and or non-governmental actors in a country by the United Nations Security Council and or African Union Peace and Security Council due to gross violations of international law. There are four possible scores for this indicator and it ranges from (0-3).

Data range

The scores for each calendar year (January to December) 2000 - 2016 reflect the sanctions on countries. The score for each year is based on the last available data –that is, the sanctions status of each country as of December 31 for each year.

Type of sanctions

The data provided only refers to sanctions imposed by UN and AU bodies on the state or non-governmental actors or both the state and non-governmental actors in the countries sampled.

Coding criteria:
